Personification is a kind of metaphorical language that places human thoughts, actions, characteristics or emotions on something that is not human. Your sentence should use this technique. When you give human characteristics to something that's not human, it's called personification. The tall tree standing guard at the gate is an example of personality. Here is a great addition to any class, where you can write a worksheet to help students identify what is personalizing and identify them in sentences, free and printable. Personification is a metaphorical language technique. When an author or speaker gives an object or idea human characteristics, abilities, or qualifications. Here is an example of personification: Frost paints pine in winter. In this example, the author gives the ability to paint frost. Frost can't paint. People paint. Because the author donned this human ability, the author personed it. It's more poetic than saying that pine trees are cold. Sometimes students have difficulty identifying personification and distinguishing it from other metaphorical language techniques. Is this because they need more practices that work with humanization examples. These worksheets will provide students with the experience they need. Personalization Worksheet 1 – Students apply identifying personalization instances and explain which human property or property of the personified object or idea.
